



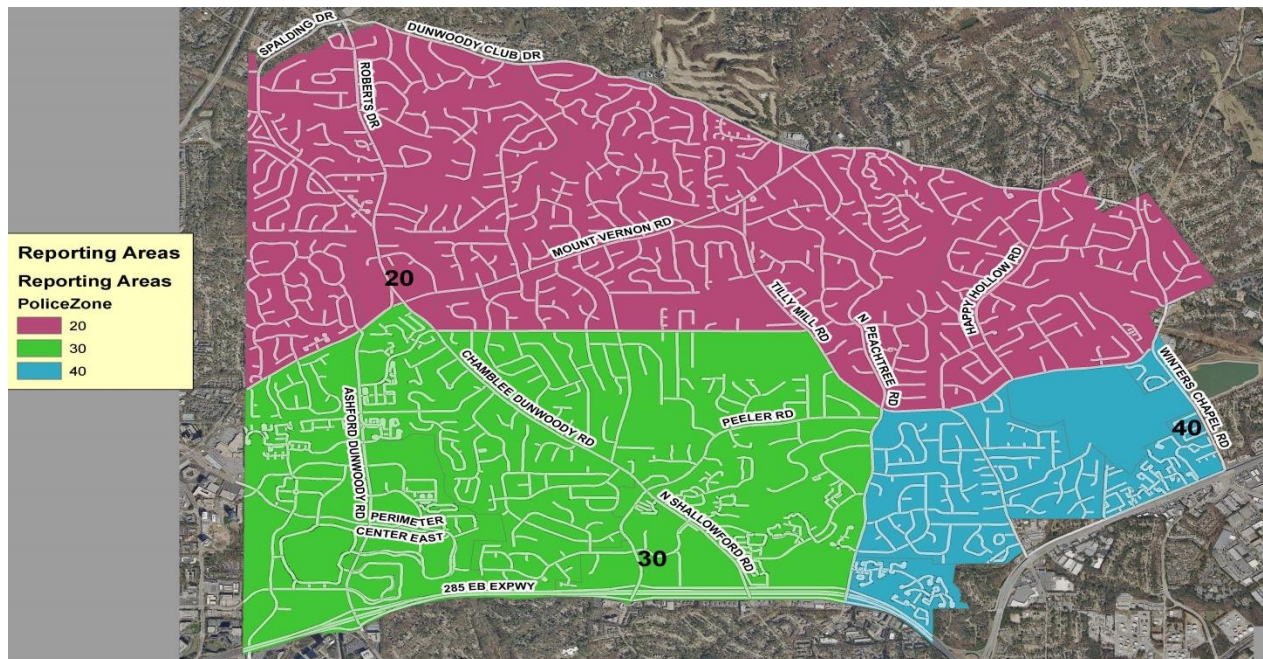

30 Beat

- Entering Auto – 4601 Ridgeview Rd (Staybridge Suites) – occurred between 5/3 at 1600 and 5/4 at 2330. The rear passenger window was broken and a laptop was removed from the floor behind the passenger seat.
- Burglary - the Flats at Mt Vernon was reported. The suspect pried the door open and removed a television, an audio mixer table and personal checks belonging to the resident. Incident occurred between 05/03/14-05/05/14.
- Motor Vehicle Theft – 4200 Blk Perimeter Center Lofts – 2 Yamaha sports bikes were stolen sometime overnight 0100 to 0900 hours. GA – TIGGRE 2005 Yamaha R1, GA – RUDYY 2013 Yamaha R6.
- Entering Auto- 4505 Ashford Dunwoody Rd – An unknown suspect(s) entered the victim's car which was left unsecured while it was parked behind Café Intermezzo. This occurred between 1600 – 1620 hours this date.
- Larceny – 4711 Ashford Dunwoody Rd (Taki Steakhouse) – the victim came to the restaurant to meet a buyer for his iPhone 5s that he listed for sale on Craigslist. When the victim produced the cell phone, the suspect grabbed it from him and fled into the wood line next to the London apartments.
- Theft/Fraud – 4503 Ashford Dunwoody Rd (Jared) – three males entered the store and tried to purchase a \$7,000 pair of earrings with a fraudulent credit card. While the manager was talking to the credit company on the phone, two of the males left the store with the earrings. The third male was taken into custody and had several more fraudulent credit cards on his person.
- Motor Vehicle Theft Attempted- was reported at Wal-Mart. When the suspect could not start the vehicle they then removed the owners wallet. Occurred between 0500-0520hrs.
- Entering auto - reported at 400 Perimeter Center Trace. The suspect broke a rear window to gain entry into the vehicle.
- Officer Tate and Tedesco responded to a single vehicle accident on Ash-Dun Rd. The driver suffered a heart attack and was unresponsive. The officers were able to save the drivers life with the use of CPR Training and the AED.
- Stolen license plate- located on a vehicle by Officer Tedesco at the mall. The tag was previously reported stolen in January at the Marriott Hotel. While waiting for the Brown & Brown, the driver and passenger arrived and were arrested. This is the second time Eric Hall has been arrested for having a stolen tag on his vehicle by our officers.

- Theft- employee at State Farm reported that her credit and debit cards had been stolen from her wallet. The cards were taken sometime between lunch time and dinner time and had been used at Target. Target security provided photos of the suspects.
- Entering auto occurred at Applebees. The passenger side rear window was broken out and several laptop bags and personal bags were taken.

- Entering auto -reported at Applebee's. The suspect broke a window of the vehicle and attempted to remove the stereo. Blood from the suspect was collected by Ofc Tomalka and entered into evidence.
- Suspicious Vehicle, 1850 Cotillion Drive. While working his part time at Madison, Officer Maldonado spotted a suspicious vehicle occupied four times in the parking deck. A stop was made and marijuana was smelled coming from the vehicle. A search revealed marijuana, a handgun, and Xanax. One of the passengers provided a false name as well. It was later determined that he was wanted for Burglary out of Cobb County. A ski mask was found in his pocket at the time of his arrest. All four subjects in the vehicle were arrested on drug charges.
