Roles, Responsibilities, and Qualifications

Lead singing in worship

- Sings in a way that invites and leads others to sing along in worship
- Comfortable with a variety of styles of music, modern and traditional

Music leadership

- Planning music for worship
- Coordinating and preparing music ensemble
- Able to play accompaniment on keys or guitar preferred

Requirements and resources

Comfort with Dunwoody Pres statements of faith, mission, and vision

Availability

- Staff or planning meeting 1 hour/week
- Worship planning and communication 2 hours/week
- Serve Sundays (8:30 am -12:30 pm.) 4 hours

Ministry resources

- A budget for equipment and supplies
- A semi-pro sound engineer, and ordinarily 1 semi-pro musician each week

Benefits and Options

- Competitive hourly compensation (\$30-60/hour starting wage depending on qualifications and availability).
- Equipping and support from Pastor and staff team
- This role has the potential to grow significantly or combine with other church staff opportunities.
- This role could become a fulltime missionary role if the candidate is willing to move into our “parish” and raise some financial support.
- We are able to create a flexible schedule that would allow for a Sunday off each month if desired.
